## Post Entries Allowed

### 1<sup>st</sup> Race: Stick Horse Race 1:00 PM

Open to children who have not had their 5<sup>th</sup> birthday as of the first of the current year. This race shall be run over approximately 6 yards on the flat. Catch weight. Open to all types of stick horses. Award for the best looking stick horse and costume for the riders.

### 2<sup>nd</sup> Race: Lead Line Race 1:15 PM

Open to children who have not had their 10<sup>th</sup> birthday as of the first of the current year. Ponies must be lead by parent with child mounted. The rider will be placed last if they canter (no matter how many tears).

### 3<sup>rd</sup> Race: Trotter Race 1:30 PM

### 4<sup>th</sup> Race: Big Hoof Horse Race: 2:00 PM

Open to Juniors and Seniors. Horse must have shoe size of 4 and up. Race will be .5 mile over five jumps 2' high.

### 5<sup>th</sup> Race: Costume Relay Race 2:30 PM

Open to Juniors and Seniors. This race shall be run over approximately 2 miles on the flat. Catch weight. Open to fairly hunted horses. Limit 4 per team. There will be 4 teams. First come, first serve.

### 6<sup>th</sup> Race: Pony Field Masters Chase \* 3:00 PM

Open to junior riders on ponies. Riders are to not have had their 16<sup>th</sup> birthday as of the first of the current year. All ponies must be a minimum of 5 years old. Catch weights. Riders are to follow the Field Master over a flagged course not to exceed 2 miles with no more than 12 obstacles none of which are to exceed 2'3". After the last fence, the Field Master will release the field to race for the finish. Entries may be asked to cue or circle before being released.

### 7<sup>th</sup> Race: Junior Field Masters Chase \* 3:30 PM

Open to junior riders on horses. Riders are to not have had their 16<sup>th</sup> birthday as of the first of the current year. All horses must be a minimum of 5 years old. Catch weights. Riders are to follow the Field Master over a flagged course not to exceed 2 miles with no more than 12 obstacles none of which are to exceed 2'6". After the last fence, the Field Master will release the field to race for the finish. Entries may be asked to cue or circle before being released. Horse whips are forbidden.

### 8<sup>th</sup> Race: Senior Field Masters Chase \* 4:00 PM

Open to amateurs who have never won a sanctioned race. All mounts are to be a minimum of 5 years old and are to not have won a sanctioned timber race in the last 3 years. Catch weights. Riders are to follow the Field Master over a flagged course not to exceed 3 miles with no more than 18 obstacles; jumps will be approximately 3'3". After the last fence, the Field Master will release the field to race for the finish. Proper hunting attire preferred. Entries may be asked to cue or circle before being released. Horse whips are forbidden.
